**PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL ADMISSION ARRANGEMENTS 2008/09**

CONSIDERED – Pursuant to Executive Procedure Rule EP 1.6 in the absence of the Cabinet Member for Children, Schools and Families, a report of the Acting Head of Learners & Young People's Service (ICM.14/07) advising on the outcome of consultations on primary and secondary admission arrangements for 2008/09 and the co-ordination of primary and secondary admission arrangements, and seeking approval to the schemes.

**DECIDED: That (1) the proposed admission arrangements for community and voluntary controlled primary and secondary schools for 2008/09 be approved;  
(2) the proposed co-ordinated admission schemes for primary and secondary schools for 2008/09 be approved.**

Reason for the recommendation: The Local authority is required to consult on and determine its admission arrangements each year, being statutorily required to co-ordinate admissions for primary and secondary schools.

Alternatives considered: None – the proposed admission arrangements are in line with School Admissions Code of Practice, and the local Authority is statutorily required to have co-ordinated admission schemes for primary and for secondary school admissions 2008/09.
