PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL ADMISSION ARRANGEMENTS 2010/11

CONSIDERED – A report of the Head of Learners & Young People's Service (ICM.1/09) advising on the outcome of consultations on Primary and Secondary School admission arrangements for 2010/11 and the Co-ordination of Primary and Secondary school admissions, and seeking approval to the schemes.

DECIDED: That (1) the proposed admission arrangements for community and voluntary controlled primary and secondary schools for 2010/11 as detailed at Appendix B to the report be approved;
(2) the proposed co-ordinated admission schemes for primary and secondary schools for 2010/11 as detailed at Appendices C and D to the report be approved.

Reason for the recommendation: The Local Authority is required to consult on and determine its admission arrangements each year, being statutorily required to co-ordinate admissions for primary and secondary schools.

Alternatives considered: None – the proposed admission arrangements are in line with School Admissions Code of Practice, and the Local Authority is statutorily required to have co-ordinated admission schemes for primary and for secondary school admissions 2010/11.
