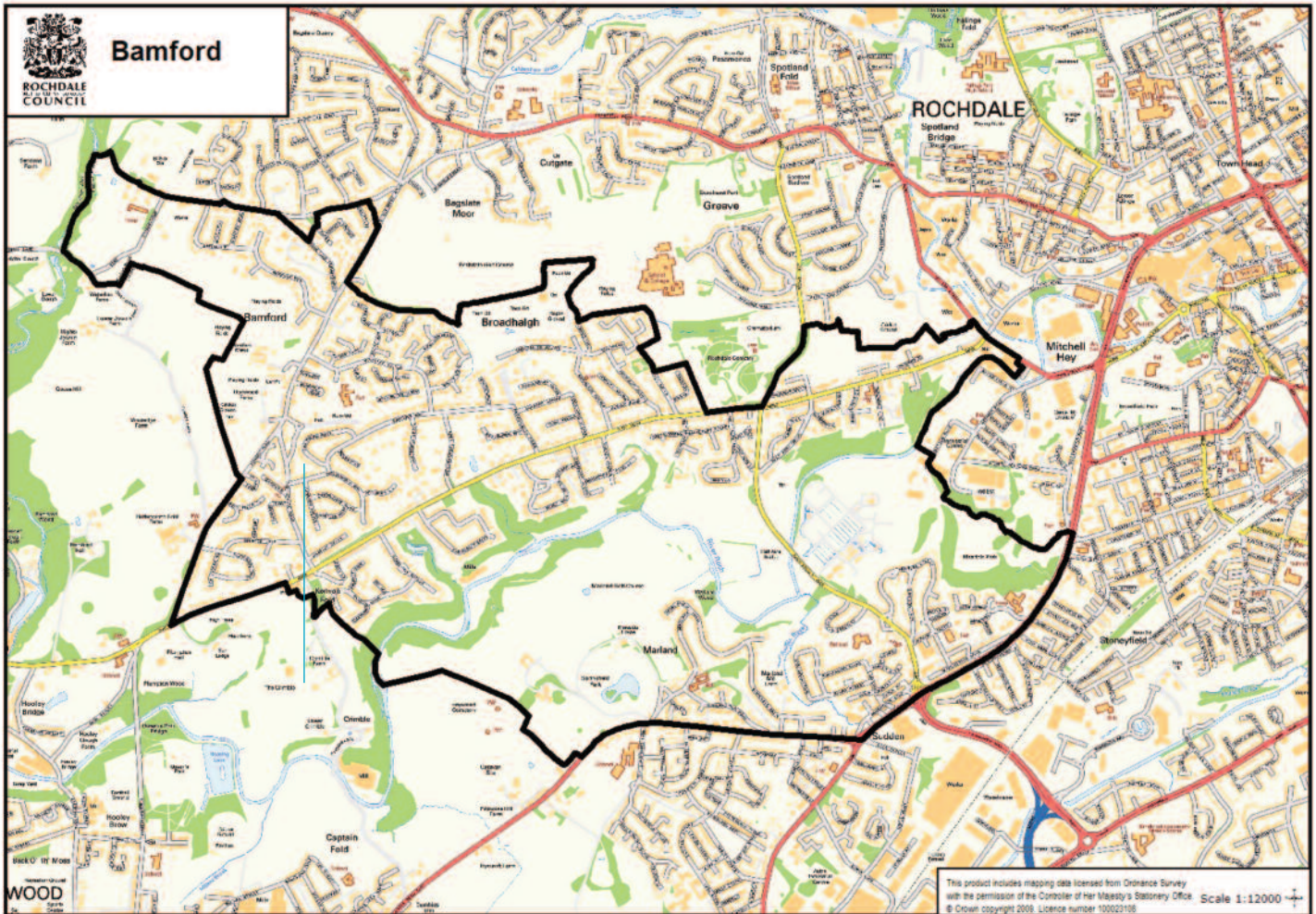
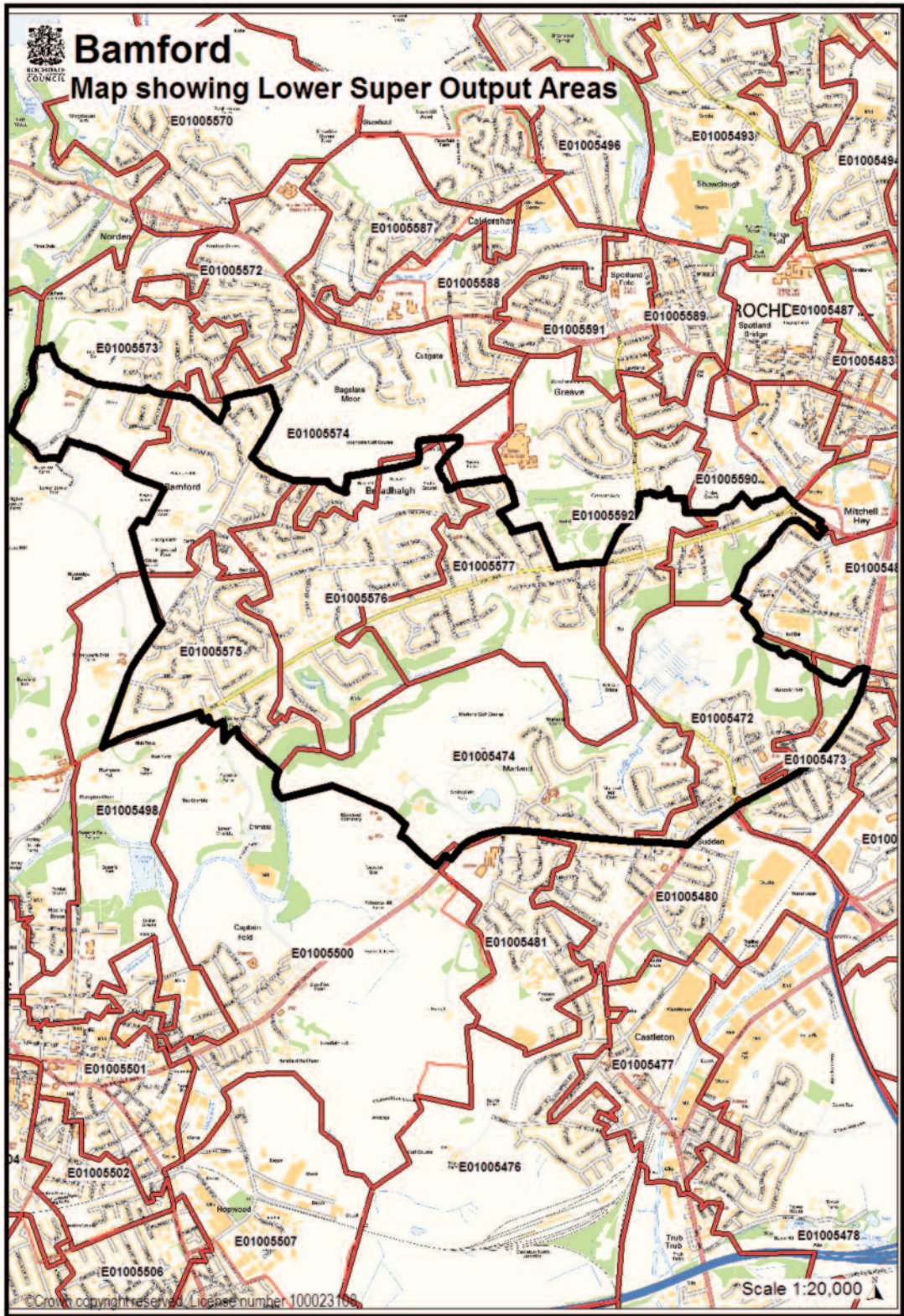


Bamford Ward Profile

- There are 9,435 people living in the Bamford ward and 3,882 households.
- In Bamford 88.83% of the population is White. The largest minority ethnic group is Pakistani with 6.85% of the population, (646).
- Couples without children account for 30.89% of households in Bamford, (1,199). This is closely followed by couples with children, who make up 29.39% of households, (1,141).
- The majority of people aged 16-74 in Bamford are economically active, (62.90%).
- 84.85% of households in Bamford own their own home, (3,294), and 7.17% rent their home from the Council, (278).

3 & 4 Year old Flexible Entitlement

The three and four year old entitlement (Early Years Grant) is universal repetition i.e. open to all children within the eligible age criteria. In Rochdale this is 15 hours per week of free early year's provision.

Some of the super output areas in this ward overlap with other wards (Castleton, Milkstone & Deeplish, Norden, Spotland & Falinge). Therefore figures for this ward cannot be seen as wholly accurate as these SOA's are reported in those other wards.

There are 261 eligible children in the SOA's shown above in this ward. 197 children resident in these ward SOA's access their free entitlement (75.5%). Providers in this ward offer 245 places (94% coverage)

122 children resident in this ward access their entitlement in 11 other wards.

The national average of take up for the childcare element of Working Tax Credit is 14%. In this ward the super output areas highlighted as **bold** are below this average and would therefore benefit from enhanced marketing and promotion of tax credit availability.

Ward summary and recommendations

In 2008 the average figure for people of working age in employment in the Borough of Rochdale was 69.3%. In determining the likely demand for childcare in each ward we have therefore assumed that this % figure of the total children in the ward would be from families who may require childcare.

We are aiming for a child to place ratios for each age range as follows:

0 – 5 year:	1 place for every 8 children
3-4 years (free entitlement)	1 place for every child
5 – 11 years (term time)	1 place for every 8 children
5 – 11 years (holidays)	1 place for every 16 children

Using these figures for the age ranges below (with the exception of 3 and 4 year old's who are in receipt of a universal free entitlement) gives the child to place ratios detailed below.

Childcare costs

Childcare costs in this ward are, in all areas, below national and regional averages. However, childminder and holiday care places are slightly above the Rochdale average.

Recommendations

- encourage membership of The Childminding Network from childminders in this ward
- promote tax credit information in SOA areas 5474 – 5573 – 5574 -5576 – 5577 – 5592
- continue to monitor costs of childminder and holiday care places and seek to keep within Rochdale average.
