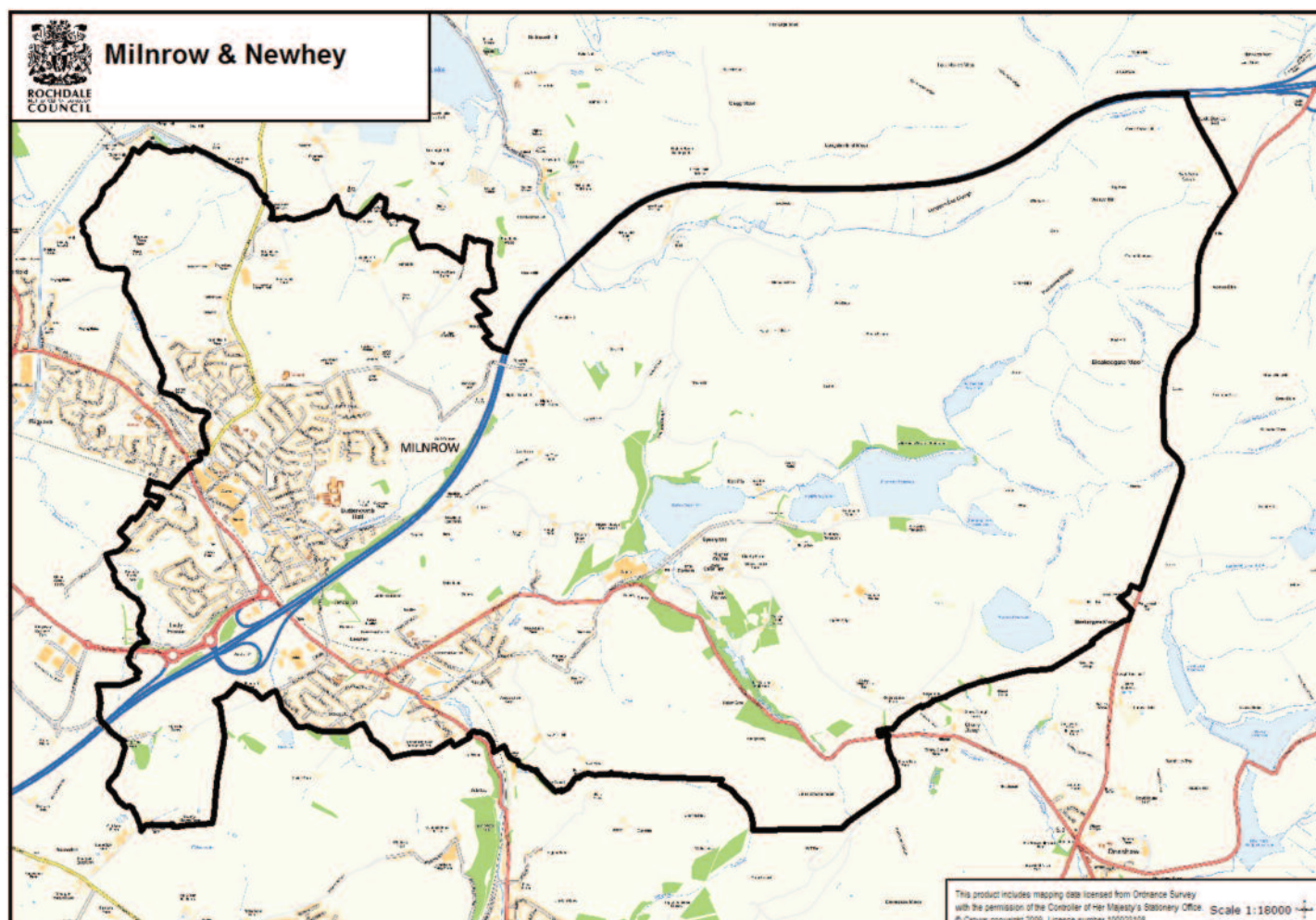


Milnrow & Newhey Ward Profile

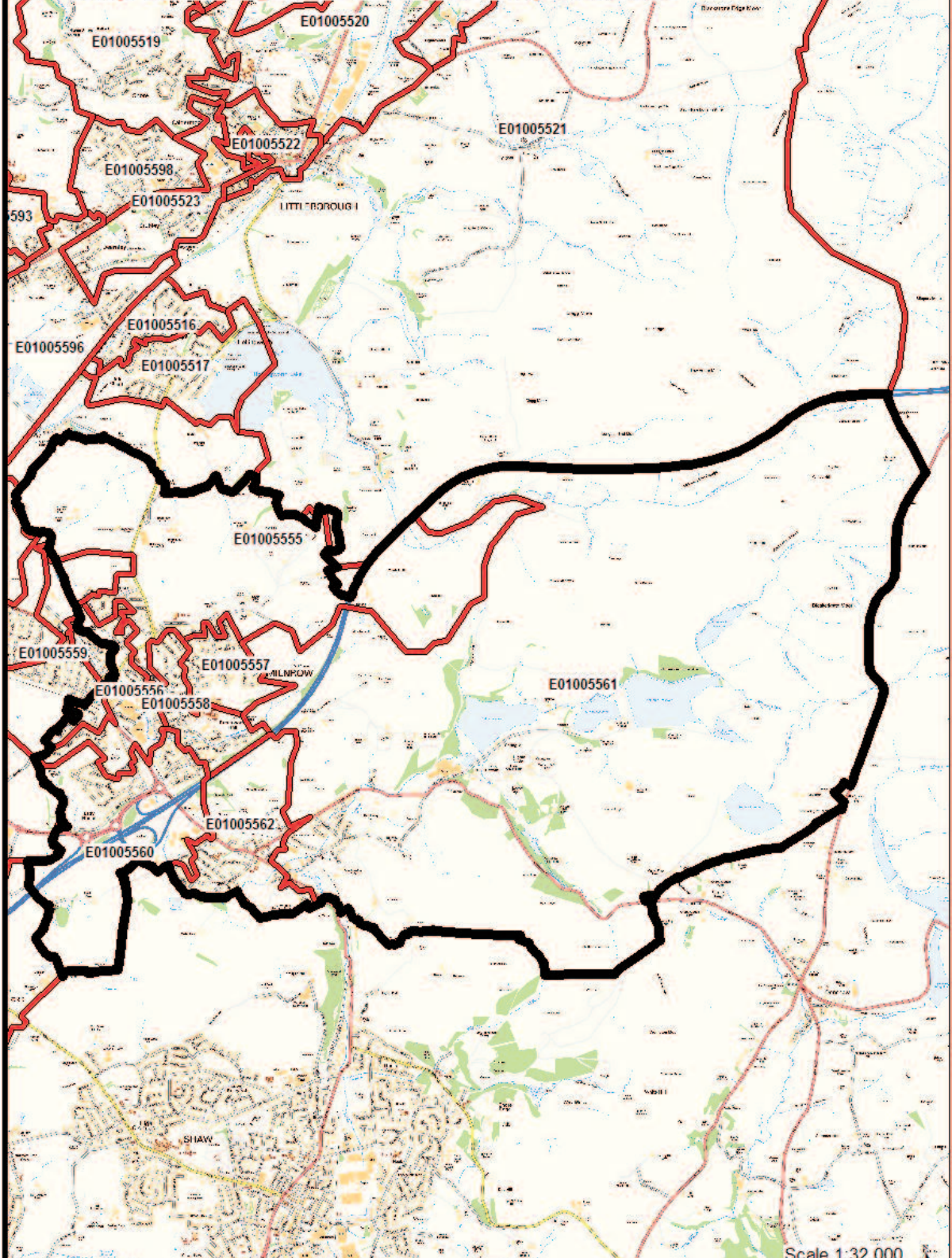
- There are 10,110 people living in the Milnrow and Newhey Ward and 4071 households.
- Children (aged 0 - 15) in Milnrow and Newhey make up 21.11% of the total population (2,133), elderly people, (aged over 75) form 5.85% of the population (592).
- In Milnrow and Newhey 98.03% of the population is white. The largest minority group is Pakistani with 4.56% (432 of the population).
- Couples with children account for 32.93% of the households in Milnrow and Newhey, (1341). This is followed by couples without children, who make up 28.38% of households, (1,154).
- The majority of people aged 15 – 74 in Milnrow and Newhey are economically active, (70.46%). Of the employed population 27.26% work in the public administration, education and health industry, (1,366). This is followed by 22.45% of people being employed in the distribution, hotel and catering industry (1,124). In Milnrow and Newhey 14.70% of people classified their occupation as being managers and senior officials, (737) and 13.84% classify their occupation as administrative and secretarial, (694).
- 80.09% of households in Milnrow and Newhey own their own home, (3260) and 11.62% rent from the Council (473)
- 47.58% (1942) of households in Milnrow and Newhey own their own home and 40.81% (1666) rent their home from the Council.

The national average of take up for the childcare element of Working Tax Credit is 14%. In this ward the super output areas highlighted as **bold** are below this average and would therefore benefit from enhanced marketing and promotion of tax credit availability.

Ward summary and recommendations

In 2008 the average figure for people of working age in employment in the Borough of Rochdale was 69.3%. In determining the likely demand for childcare in each ward we have therefore assumed that this % figure of the total children in the ward would be from families who may require childcare.

We are aiming for a child to place ratios for each age range as follows:

0 - 5 years:	1 place for every 8 children
3 - 4 years (free entitlement)	1 place for every child
5 - 11 years (term time)	1 place for every 8 children
5 - 11 years (holidays)	1 place for every 16 children

Using these figures for the age ranges below (with the exception of 3 and 4 year old's who are in receipt of a universal free entitlement) gives the child to place ratios detailed below
