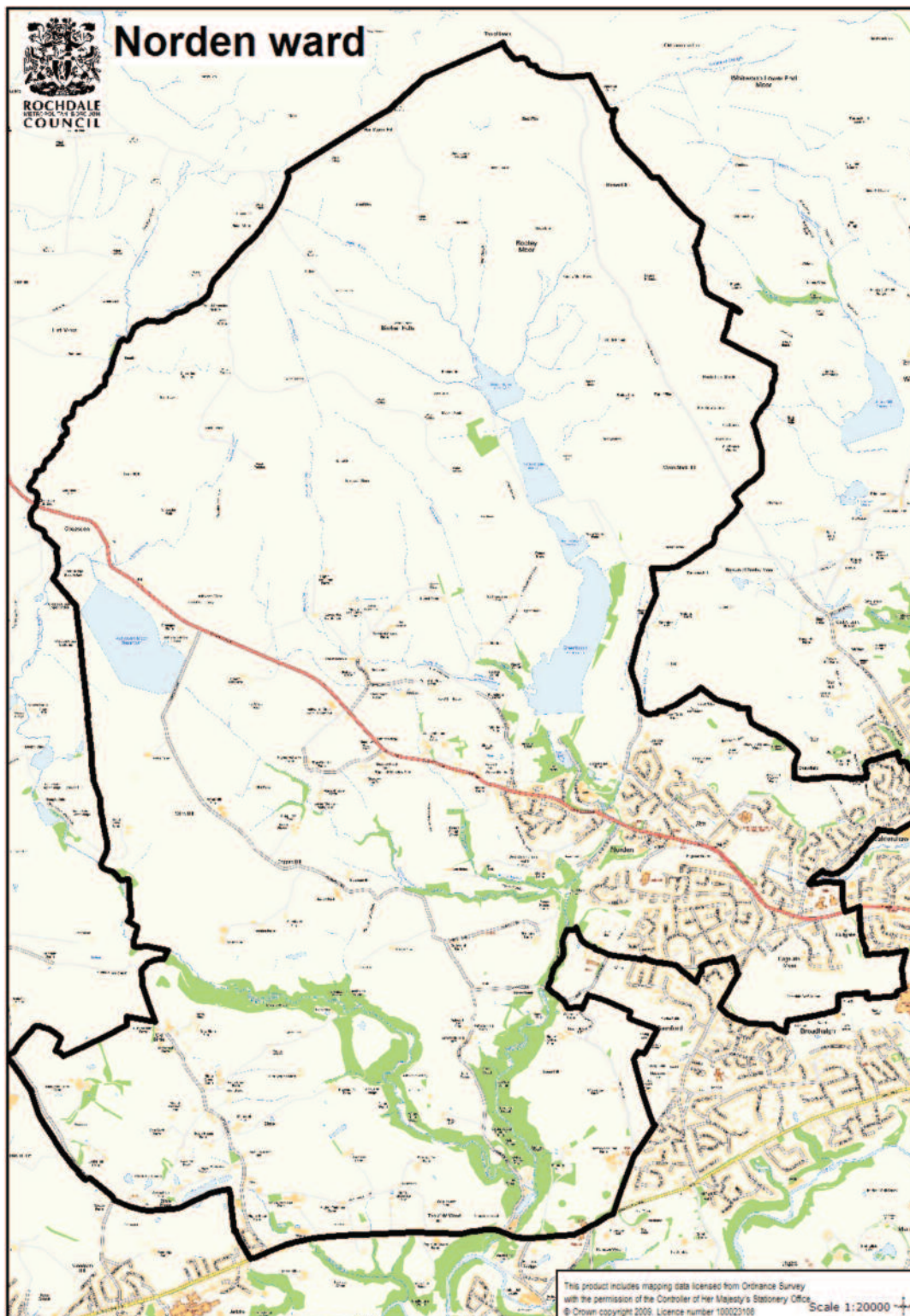


Norden Ward Profile

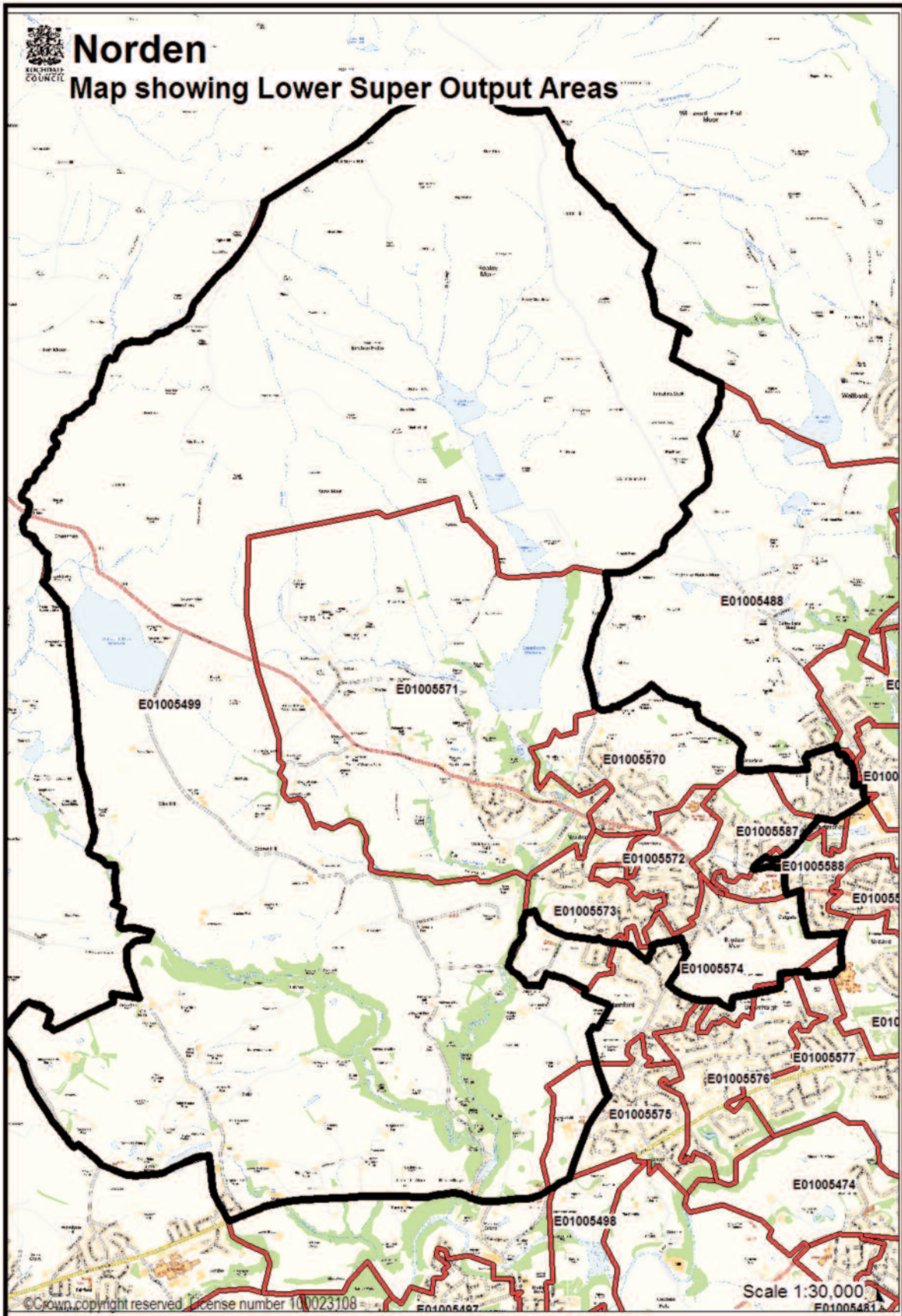
- There are 9,867 people living in the Norden ward and 3,810 households.
- Children, (aged 0-15), in Norden make up 22.78% of the total population, (2,248).
- In Norden 95.82% of the population is White. The largest minority ethnic group is Pakistani with 2.41% of the population, (238).
- Couples with children account for 39.02% of households in Norden, (1,487). This is followed by couples without children, who make up 31.36% of the households, (1,194).
- The majority of people aged 16-74 in Norden are economically active, (76.24%).
- 91.21% of households in Norden own their own home, (3,475), and 4.92% rent their home from a private landlord, (188).

The national average of take up for the childcare element of Working Tax Credit is 14%. In this ward the super output areas highlighted as **bold** are below this average and would therefore benefit from enhanced marketing and promotion of tax credit availability.

Ward summary and recommendations

In 2008 the average figure for people of working age in employment in the Borough of Rochdale was 69.3%. In determining the likely demand for childcare in each ward we have therefore assumed that this % figure of the total children in the ward would be from families who may require childcare.

We are aiming for a child to place ratios for each age range as follows:

0 - 5 years	1 place for every 8 children
3 - 4 years (free entitlement)	1 place for every child
5 - 11 years (term time)	1 place for every 8 children
5 - 11 years (holidays)	1 place for every 16 children

Using these figures for the age ranges below (with the exception of 3 and 4 year old's who are in receipt of a universal free entitlement) gives the child to place ratios detailed below
